Although there have been many challenges to navigate through, we are thankful for the many stories of Charis Fellowship churches responding to various needs in creative and God honoring ways. 2021 Fellowship Fee & Donation Worksheet

Due to the challenges of recording average attendance during 2020, Charis Fellowship delegates made the decision last July to use the average weekly attendance details for 2019 to determine this year's Fellowship Fee.

Please follow the instructions to fill in the options that apply to you:

Name and Location of Church:

1. Average weekly attendance you reported for 2019 ➔ A

2. Enter the per person fellowship fee based on the criteria below:

Per person fellowship fee before May 15, 2021 = \$6.85 ➔ B
